HIV and AIDS

- Your body has a mechanism to act against disease. This is called your body's immune system. HIV is a virus that weakens the body's immune system, that is, its <u>power</u> to fight disease. This virus can <u>pass</u> from one person to another through body fluids such as blood, semen, vaginal secretions, or a mother's breast milk.
- HIV causes AIDS although not everyone who has the virus looks sick. It can take from six months to ten or more years before someone who has HIV, that is, who is HIV positive, becomes sick with AIDS. The only way to find out if someone has the disease is for them to get tested for the virus.
- HIV can pass from one person to another <u>through</u> unprotected sex if one of them is infected with it. Infection can also take place by sharing needles for drugs. In addition, it can pass from a mother to her baby before it is born or through breast feeding, from the mother's milk. But only about 1/3 of babies of HIV positive mothers are infected this way.
 - Right now, there is no <u>way</u> to cure AIDS. <u>Eventually</u>, people suffering from AIDS die. There are medicines to fight this terrible disease, but nothing cures it yet. Scientists around the world are trying to find a cure for AIDS.

Having unprotected sex with a person who is infected is dangerous. In fact, it is the most common way the disease is spread. Thinking carefully about sex, discussing sex with your partner and trying to have <u>safe</u> sex (for example using a condom during sex) are some ways that the infection can be reduced.
